I hope you will guide your learners on the topics for early preparations. I will be thankful when my request will be accepted.

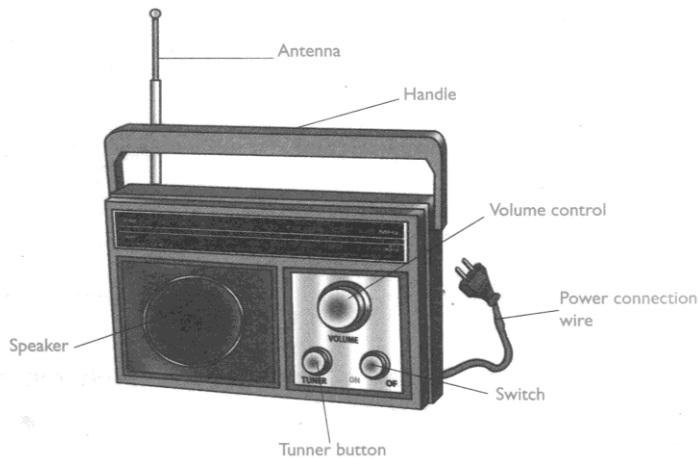
